

大阪大学優秀な私費外国人留学生に対する授業料免除制度
(特待留学生授業料免除制度)について

大阪大学大学院歯学研究科博士課程の募集要項に記載の優秀な私費外国人留学生に対する授業料免除制度(特待留学生授業料免除制度)の詳細は、以下のとおりです。

1. 免除対象者

以下のすべてに該当する者

- ① 在留資格が「留学」である者。
- ② 国費外国人留学生、外国政府派遣留学生等により授業料の支援を受けていない者。
- ③ 民間奨学金等により、授業料支援を目的とした授業料相当額の支援を受けていない者。

免除決定後、①～③のいずれかに該当しなくなった場合は、以下に連絡してください。

2. 免除内容

全額免除とする。

3. 免除期間

標準修業年限の間

ただし、休学した期間は免除対象期間に含めるものとし、復学後に免除期間の繰り延べは行わない。当該課程入学時から起算して標準修業年限を経過した後は免除対象外とする。

4. 授業料免除停止事項

次の場合には授業料免除を取り止める。

- ① 「留学」の在留資格を取得せずに渡日したとき又は「留学」の在留資格が他の在留資格に変更になったとき。
- ② 標準修業年限内での修了が不可能であることが確定したとき。
- ③ 学則等に則り、停学等の懲戒処分を受けたとき。
- ④ 他の制度により授業料免除を受けたとき。
- ⑤ 学業成績等により本制度による免除対象者としてふさわしくないと大学が判断したとき。

5. 申請方法

申請を希望する者は、大学院入試の出願の際に以下のとおり申請を行ってください。

(1)「入学願書」の【授業料免除制度(特待留学生授業料免除)への申請の有無欄】の『有』にチェックを入れる。

(2)次に掲げる書類を大学院入試にかかる出願書類と併せて提出する。

- ① 論文業績や国際学会での発表経験等、研究実績について記載した書類(様式任意)
- ② 志願する講座の長の推薦状(様式任意)

6. 選考結果発表

合格者発表時に併せて通知します。

7. その他

本制度による授業料免除者は、従来からの経済的困難を有する学生を対象とした授業料免除制度への申請はしないでください。

Osaka University Tuition Fee Exemption System for International Students of Excellent
Academic Standing:
Tuition Fee Exemption for International Honors Students

Below are the details of this system described in the Application Guidelines for the Doctoral Program of the Graduate School of Dentistry, Osaka University.

1. Eligible Persons

Students who fall under all of the following:

- (i) Those whose status of residence is "Student"
- (ii) Those who are not receiving financial aid for tuition fees, such as Japanese Government Scholarship Students (MEXT students) or foreign government-sponsored students, etc.
- (iii) Those who are not receiving financial aid equivalent to the amount of tuition fees to cover such fees from scholarship foundations, etc.

If any of (i) through (iii) becomes inapplicable after the exemption has been notified, please contact the following.

2. Exemption Details

Full tuition exemption

3. Exemption Period

The exemption period will be the standard period of study for the completion of the enrolled program/course.

Please note that the period of a leave of absence shall be included in the exemption period and the exemption period shall not be extended after reenrollment. Students who have been enrolled longer than the standard period of study from their enrollment in the program/course will become ineligible for the exemption.

4. Suspension of Tuition Fee Exemption

Tuition fee exemption will be revoked in the following cases:

- In the case of arriving in Japan without obtaining a "Student" status of residence or in the case that the status of residence of "Student" is changed to another status of residence.
- It is confirmed that completion within the standard period of study is not possible.
- Disciplinary action such as suspension is received in accordance with the university rules and regulations.
- Tuition fee exemption is granted under another system.
- The university determines that exemption under this system is not suitable due to

academic performance, etc.

5. How to apply

Applicants who wish to apply for the tuition fee exemption system must submit the application as follows at the time of applying for the Entrance Examination.

(1) Check "Yes" in the "Application for Tuition Fee Exemption System (Tuition Fee for International Students of Excellent Academic Standing)" box at the bottom of the application form.

(2) Submit the following documents along with the application materials.

(i) Documents describing the applicant's research achievements, such as publications and presentations at international conferences (any format).

(ii) A letter of recommendation from the PI of the laboratory to which the applicant is applying (any format).

6. Notification of Selection Results

Notification will be made at the same time as the announcement of the successful candidates.

8. Additional Information

Students who receive tuition fee exemption under this system should not apply for another tuition fee exemption under other systems that support students who have difficulty paying fees due to economic reasons.
